**Update from the City on Road Closures**: David Mancini (<a href="mailto:dmancinijr@dmsi.co">dmsi.co</a>) & Project Manager Krishan Kandial (<a href="kkandial@fortlauderdale.gov">kkandial@fortlauderdale.gov</a>) from City of Fort Lauderdale: Monday: 2 middle lanes will be closed along with median on 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue south of 17<sup>th</sup>. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed North of 15<sup>th</sup> Street, and traffic will be funneled to Miami Rd. There will be NO parking available on NE 10<sup>th</sup> Ave. during this time, but crossing will be available and an additional crossing guard will be employed. This will be until June. There may be further closures over the summer. The work involves tunneling underground to insert a new pipe. This old pipe will be refurbished, so it can be a backup in the future.

Book Fair and Spring photos are not added to budget yet. We will meet to set up new budget soon. Expenses are on track at \$49,845 so far. We need more tables. Ms. Bureau requested money for mints on FSA testing day as incentives for kids. We have some extra mini-grant expenses coming up, so motion was proposed to raise mini grant budget. Krisit Quarles motioned to raise the mini grant budget to \$3,000. Gina Reynan seconded it. Motion approved.

**School supplies**: Gina Reynan: She is pricing out school supply list, and it will be alive and ready before K roundup on 4/3. We might look at other companies that ship in the future.
